DAY 5 Matthew 11:28

Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest.

DAY 6 Matthew 16:26

For what shall a man be profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and forfeit his life?

DAY 7 Matthew 22:37

You shall love Jehovah your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.

DAY 8 Matthew 24:42

Mark 8:34

DAY 10 Mark 9:35

If any man would be first, he shall be last of all, and servant of all.

Affirmation: I serve others with humility, and God honors me.

DAY 11 Luke 6:27

But I say to you that hear, Love your enemies, do good to them that hate you.

Jesus Christ's call to love extends even to those who oppose us.

Affirmation: I choose to love my enemies and do good to those who oppose me.

DAY 12 Luke 12:15

Beware! Keep yourselves from covetousness, for a man's life does not consist of the abundance of the things which he possesses.

DAY 13 Luke 14:11

John 8:12
